Arrival Date and Meeting Point

Delegations/Individuals must proceed directly to the meeting point in the Sydney Olympic Park Sports Centre for registration of accreditation and/or payments on <u>Monday September 24th</u>, <u>2018.</u>

Each delegation will be responsible for their own expenses whilst attending the World Cup.

Registration

Registration of Competitors, Coaches, VIPs, Supporters and others will be coordinated by International Taekwon-Do Federation.

From March 1st, 2018 you can apply for the competitor's ID Card through https://www.sportdata.org

Once you receive your Black Belt ID numbers, you will be able to login your competitors and participants through the Sportdata online system.

Competition Rules

Competition rules will be the 2018 ITF World Cup Rules, Amendments and Appendixes.

Competitors shall compete in the divisions laid down in the ITF World Cup rules, and must be of the appropriate indicated age at the day of the official weigh-in on Tuesday September 25^{th} , 2018.

Competitors in all divisions must be healthy and registered with their National or Allied Associations.

All competitors must apply to the World Cup 2018 by using their ITF online ID number. to register as a participant at the World Cup 2018. All black belts automatically have this number which can be obtained from your own organisation. Blue and red belts will need to apply for this number through their National Association and/or Allied Association.











ITF ID Card and National passport / Weigh In

The ITF ID Card and National passport Control for all competitors and Weigh In shall take place on <u>Tuesday September 25th, 2018 from 9am-1pm</u>, according to the time table per delegates in the Sydney Olympic Park Sports Centre.

All Competitors must find their own way to register and be present at the Weigh In.

Competitors must make the weigh in wearing their ITF approved dobok trousers and T-shirt or Polo shirt. A maximum of 500 gram margin over the indicated weight category is permitted.

Competitors not making their weight at the 1st attempt will have one (1) hour to present themselves for the 2nd and last attempt. If he/she doesn't make the weight then he/she shall be removed from the sparring competition category and shall not be allowed to enter any other weight category.

Divisions

The World Cup will be for the following competitors:

Pre Junior	12-14 years old	Pre-Juniors must be 12 years old at the day of the official weigh-in on Tuesday September 25 th , 2018.
Junior	15-17 years old	Juniors must be 15 years old at the day of the official weigh-in on Tuesday September 25 th , 2018
Senior	18-35 years old	Seniors must be 18 years old at the day of the official weigh-in on Tuesday September 25 th , 2018
Advanced Senior	36-45 years old	Advanced seniors must be 36 years old at the day of the official weigh-in on Tuesday September 25 th , 2018
Veteran	46 years and older	Veterans must be 46 years old at the day of the official weigh-in on Tuesday September 25 th , 2018

- Blue and Red Belts (one division)

Equipment regulations

All competitors must wear the official ITF dobok and protection gear from the sponsors as shown at the ITF website - www.taekwondoitf.org - under "Approved equipment".

All competitors in sparring competition must use protection gear in red or blue colour depending on the draw.

Entry fees (€ - Euro)

Competitors entry fee (both individuals and/or team members): **€100 per competitor** (also for competitors taking part as only team members)

Team entry fee: €100 per team

Coach ID card amount: €50 per coach

All Non ITF members may participate at the event however they need to request permission for participation from the National Association in their country. If permission by the NA is granted the following amounts need to be paid: Please see ITF website for registered associations in your country www.taekwondoitf.org

Individuals: €150 per competitor Team entry fee: €150 per team Coach ID card amount: €50 per coach

Please remember to include the amount for the bank transfer costs at your end. If the Organizing Committee must pay for the bank transfer costs, then you will need to pay this amount on arrival.

The remaining balance (50%) of the registration fees must be paid on arrival by cash at the registration desk located in the Sydney Olympic Park however if you wish, the whole amount may be transferred by **August 1st, 2018**. Credit/debit or other card payments will not be accepted.

Insurance

The Organizing Committee of the World Cup 2018 will NOT be financially responsible for any possible injuries caused during the competition. All competitors must have full insurance coverage by their own organization.

Free Training Facilities

Free training facilities are available from Tuesday September 25th, 2018 at Sydney Olympic Park Quay Centre, and available throughout the event.

Please note that ITF and/or Organizing Committee will not handle any flights or accommodation booking.

We offer 4 different levels of accommodation during your stay at the World Cup. You can choose between 4 Star Hotel, 3 Star Hotel, 2.5 Star Plus Hotel and Serviced Apartments. In each level of accommodation there are rooms that cater for 1 or 2, 3, 4 or even 6 people.

For Accommodation between 24th September and 30th September, the following rates apply.

Countries and their participants <u>NOT</u> booking their Hotel accommodation through JC Travel Agency shall pay €100 per person to obtain the competition ID card.

Please note that the number of different types of rooms are limited! We will handle applications in the order they are received. This means that those who send their applications first will have first priority.

If you wish to stay for a holiday after the competition it is possible to book extra nights with all level accommodation.

Organizers and JC Travel seek to ensure that the competitors will be placed to the closest hotel to the Sydney Olympic Park Quay Centre.











How to book your Flights & Accommodation

Step 1

Book directly with JC Travel - bookings@jctravel.com.au

Flights refer to the above for site for detailed information regarding this.

50 percent (50%) of total Hotel accommodation prices must be transferred and cleared by <u>July 25th,</u> <u>2018</u> to the Organizing Committee Bank Account (see above).

Please remember to include the amount for the bank transfer costs at your end. If the Organizing Committee has to pay for the bank transfer costs then you will need to pay this amount on arrival.

Credit/debit or other card payments or cash payments will not be accepted.

Please note that the booking will not be accepted until the requested amount has been registered on the Organizing Committee Bank Account.

Step 2

After the amount has been accounted, your booking will be officially accepted. This will be confirmed to the responsible person of each Delegation.

Step 3

The full accommodation balance must be paid <u>on or before August 24th, 2018</u> to the Organizing Committee Bank Account. You may pay the whole accommodation amount in advance if you wish to do so.

Step 4

It is possible to make small changes in the hotel accommodation reservation until <u>August 23rd, 2018.</u>
After this date it is not possible to change the reservations and the accommodation form will be used as the base of calculating the accommodation cost for each delegation.

Umpires

Selected Umpires must arrive on Monday September 24th, 2018 and depart on Sunday September 30th, 2018.

The Organizing Committee will cover a 7 days/6 nights hotel accommodation including full board from Monday September 24th, 2018 to Sunday September 30th, 2018 for a maximum of 85 Umpires.

Umpires will be accommodated in double (2 persons) rooms.











Where an Umpire is sharing accommodation, the guest will need to pay the 4 star rated accommodation €90 per day (breakfast and dinner is included). Buffet lunch is available for €20.

Umpires not selected, but wishing to participate and approved by the ITF Umpire Committee, must cover their hotel accommodation according to above mentioned arrangements and will not receive any expense reimbursement by ITF.

Umpires must attend the Umpire meetings on <u>Tuesday 25th September 2018</u> in the Sydney Olympic Quay Centre.

Umpires not present at the above-mentioned umpire meetings shall be removed from the umpire list and shall pay their own hotel accommodation expenses.

Countries must send the "2018 WC Sydney, Australia Umpire Application Form.xlsx" to the ITF Umpire Committee - itfuc13@gmail.com - on or before March 31st, 2018 in order to apply for their Umpires to be selected for the ITF World Cup 2018. Please refer to www.itfworldcup2018.com for more information regarding this, available shortly.

The Umpire Committee shall inform the selected Umpires on May 1st, 2018 about their participation in the event.

The ITF Umpire Committee shall provide the Umpire booking list to JC Travel entitled to take care of the required hotel accommodation.

Coaches

Coaches must attend the Coaches meeting on <u>Tuesday September 25th</u>, **2018 at 16.00 hrs** in the Sydney Olympic Sports Centre.

Supporters

Supporters wishing to obtain the supporters ID Card must apply for it through their Delegation. The responsible of the Delegation shall insert them in the online registration website.

At arrival at the Olympic Centre the responsible of the Delegation must withdraw the supporters ID Card paying the amount of \leq 30 in cash for each supporter.











The ID card provides the following advantages:

- FREE entry at the Sport Stadium (daily ticket cost: €13)
- FREE entry at the Taekwon-Do Party on Saturday night.

Supporters are NOT allowed to enter the competition areas in any case. Those not complying with this rule shall result by withdrawal of the ID card.

Press

Organizer has its own Press staff therefore no others will be allowed in the competition area.

Currency

The currency used in Australia is the Australian Dollar (AUD). Organizer Committee suggest changing money to AUD, if you want to go shopping.

Visa

Anti-Doping Commission

The ITF confirms the presence of the Anti-Doping Commission.

Extraordinary circumstances

The Organizing Committee of the World Cup 2018 is NOT responsible for ANY consequences caused by possible delays or cancellations of air planes or other transportation used by the participating teams travelling to Australia.

Therefore, the prepayment for hotel accommodation made before the World Cup 2018 will not be refunded.

- July 25th, 2018 Payment of 50% deposit for competitors and team entry fees.
- July 25th, 2018 Submit the "Accommodation form" and pay 50% deposit of the total amount due for the entire delegation
- August 23rd, 2018 Last date to request small changes/corrections in your hotel booking.
- August 24th, 2018 Final date to pay hotel accommodation balance.
- September 1st, 2018 Deadline for adding or changing participants.
- September 24th, 2018 The remaining balance (50%) of the registration fees must be paid on arrival by cash at the registration desk located in the Sydney Olympic Park however if you wish, the whole amount may be transferred by <u>August 1st</u>, 2018.
